Guidelines for Temporary Signs

NO TEMPORARY SIGNS, INCLUDING ELECTION SIGNS, ARE ALLOWED IN TOWN OR CDOT RIGHT-OF-WAYS

Residential Lots

- 1) Temporary signs must be placed at least 10 feet back from Town Right-of-Ways and 15 feet back from CDOT Right-of-Ways.
- 2) One temporary sign is allowed on each residential lot without a permit.
- 3) You must have permission from the property owner to place the sign on their lot.
- 4) If you place more than one temporary sign on a single residential lot, you will be required to get a temporary sign permit. (\$5.00 permit fee)
- 5) All temporary signs on residential lots that are not election signs are required to show the date the sign is first displayed in the lower right-hand corner.
- 6) Signs must be 4 square feet or less in size and made of durable material. (No cardboard or paper signs.)
- 7) Banners are not allowed.

Non-Residential Lots

- 1) Does not require a permit.
- 2) Temporary signs must be placed at least 10 feet back from Town Right-of-Ways and 15 feet back from CDOT Right-of-Ways.
- 3) You must have permission from the property owner to place the sign on their lot.
- 4) Must be less than 32 square feet.
- 5) Date of first display must be placed on lower right-hand corner.
- 6) May be displayed for 30 days, up to 4 times per year.
- 7) Banners and feather banners are required to have a banner permit and have their own guidelines and requirements. (\$5.00 permit fee)

Election Signs

- 1) Do not require a permit.
- 2) Limited to 1 sign per ballot issue or candidate.
- 3) May not be displayed sooner than 30 days before the election and must be taken down within 2 days after election end.
