 - Allow the Town unrestricted access to the site to conduct regular site inspections;
 - Comply with all requirements of the accepted GESC Plan and GESC Permit;
 - Immediately cease land-disturbing activities upon receipt of a written Stop Work Order from an authorized representative of the Town of Elizabeth. A Stop Work Order shall be issued and this Permit revoked if the Permittees are not in compliance with the GESC Permit and/or GESC Plan or the Permittees fail to take corrective action within the time specified on the written notification of such non-compliance;Understand that in addition to other remedies, a violation of this GESC Permit shall constitute a violation of Section 16-3-110, subsections (j) and (k), and/or Section 16-2-40 of the Town of Elizabeth Municipal Code, as applicable; and
 - Understand any approval obtained from the Town does not obviate your need to comply with the requirements of Sections 7 and 9 of the Endangered Species Act of 1973 or with any other applicable federal, state or local laws or regulations.

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PERMIT FEES FOR THE TOWN'S GRADING, EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PERMITS

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ELIZABETH, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The Town hereby establishes permit fees for its Grading, Erosion and Sediment Control ("GES") Permits as follows:

Permit fee


Five (5) acres or less: \$1,200; and

Over five (5) acres: \$2,750.
