Paving Project Updates: ALL NEWLY PAVED STREETS

The majority of the paving project for all four streets has been completed. There are however smaller items that still need to be addressed and work will continue to bring these items into completion. Public Works and Native Suns will be performing a walk-through punch-list of items to be addressed the week of December 20th. Once the list is compiled the work will be begin after the Holidays during the week of January 3, 2022. These items may take several weeks to complete, and we ask that you are patient during completion. If you have concerns or questions, please feel free to contact Mike DeVol directly to have them addressed. Public Works will be installing signage, such as speed limit, parking, no parking, Stop, and deer crossing signs to name a few. The work will continue for the Mail Kiosks locations as weather allows. Paving to complete parking areas will likely take place in March or April due to temperature lows and asphalt availability. Road base gravel is being installed in these areas temporarily for ease of access and driving. Mail Kiosks will likely not be functioning until coordination with the USPS in February/March is completed. Thank you for your cooperation.
