The Town of Elizabeth has been working with the Colorado Department of Local Affairs (DOLA) and the University of Colorado – Denver, University Technical Assistance Program to begin designing a Town facility to be used as a community and senior active center. We look forward to the leadership and professionalism that Jeff brings to the organization.
