### Outdoor watering conservation suggestions May 1 to Oct. 1.

- Water during cooler times of the day.
- Water no more than three days per week.
- Run each zone 15 to 20 minutes.
- Do not allow water to pool in gutters, streets, and alleys.
- Do not waste water by letting it spray on concrete and asphalt.
- Repair leaking sprinkler systems.
