Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Information

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 requires that “no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.”

In accordance with the requirements of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (“ADA”) and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Town of Elizabeth will not discriminate against qualified individuals with disabilities on the basis of disability in its facilities, services, programs, or activities.

A complaint regarding the provision of facilities, services, activities, programs or benefits by the Town should be in writing and contain information about the alleged discrimination such as name, address, phone number of complainant and location, date, and description of the problem. Alternative means of filing complaints will be made available for persons with disabilities upon request.
